Destination

Known as "KL" by local residents, Kuala Lumpur boasts an impressive array of sightseeing attractions, including the nearly 1,479-foot-tall (451-meter-tall) Petronas Twin Towers, the Sultan Abdul Samad Building and the National Mosque of Malaysia. The cuisine is highly influenced by both Indian and Chinese flavors, though much of the street food reflects Javanese, Arabian, Thai, Sumatran and Japanese.

Approximately 50 miles (80 kilometers) northeast of Kuala Lumpur is the small town of Bukit Tinggi. Tucked away in a tropical rainforest in Berjaya Hills, it offers a change of scenery from the bustling city. Visitors enjoy Colmar Tropicale, an entertainment resort that resembles a medieval French village. Other attractions include the Japanese Village & Botanical Garden and nearby Genting Highlands entertainment resort, home to a theme park and casino.

Board the Holland America ms Noordam in Sydney, Australia, for a 13-night South Pacific cruise to New Caledonia, Vanuatu and Fiji. Spend 2 relaxing days at sea, and then stop at Noumea, New Caledonia, where popular attractions include Baie des Citrons – a trendy leisure area with beaches, restaurants and bars – and Place des Cocotiers, a shady square near the waterfront. Your next port is on Lifou Island, the largest and most populous of the Loyalty Islands. The largest raised coral atoll in the world, Lifou is ideal for a swim or snorkeling for a glimpse at the diverse marine life. Cruise on to Vila, Vanuatu – site of the Underwater Post Office – and stay active playing golf, horseback riding, sailing or hiking. Just don't forget your camera!

Continue to Lautoka, Fiji, also known as "Sugar City," and the country's 2nd-largest city, situated in the center of the sugar cane-growing region. Visit the Lautoka Market in the business district for the perfect souvenir, or spend the day soaking up the sun on stretches of beach along the coast.

The next day takes you to the narrow, volcanic Dravuni Island, a remote piece of paradise covering less than 200 acres. This Fijian island hosts a research facility to survey reefs for the country's tourism ministry. Then stop at Mare Island, New Caledonia. This French territory is the 2nd-largest of the Loyalty Islands, and has plenty of local markets and shops to explore. After 2 final days at sea, conclude your journey in Sydney and disembark.

What we love:

- Introduced to the island in 1860, vanilla is now a vital crop and major economic staple of Lifou, often referred to as "brown gold."
- Considered the French Riviera of the Pacific, Noumea presents visitors with the chance to experience French culture, cuisine, style and shopping while enjoying the island lifestyle.
- Look for a game of petanque, similar to bocce and horseshoes, during your time in Noumea.
